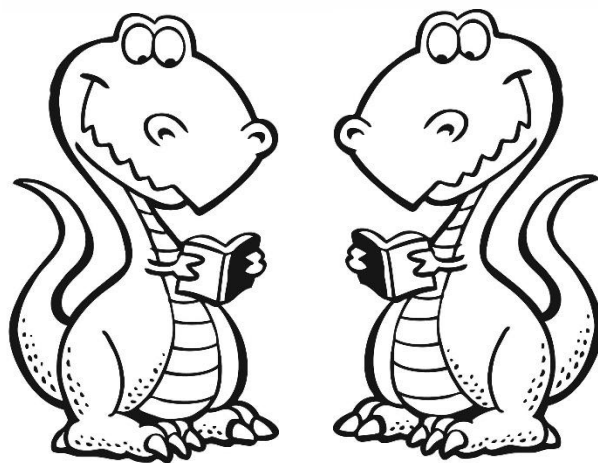

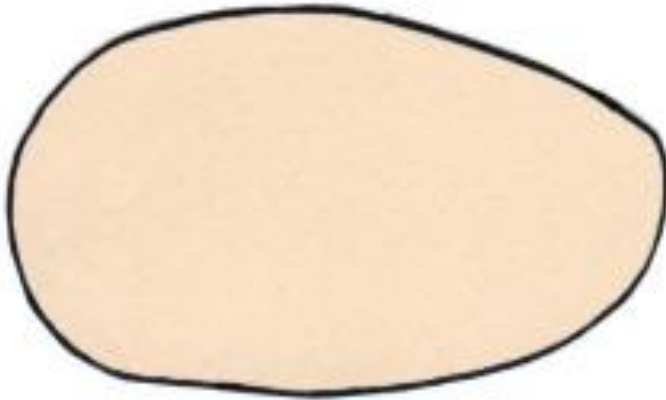

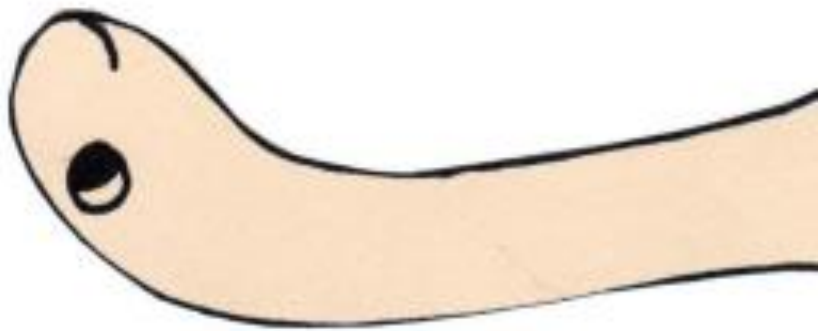

# *Paper Dinosaur Instructions*

Materials:

- The Paper Dinosaur Template (Found on previous page)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloring Materials (Markers, Crayons, etc.)
- Helpful Buddy
- Construction Paper (Optional)

**Step 1:** Cut-out all your pieces from the template. You may need your helpful buddy to cut out the pieces. With the legs you can either keep the legs as one big piece or cut them out individually

**Step 2:** Glue the pieces onto the oval shape (the body). Take your glue stick and glue a little bit of the edge of each piece to stick on the body. (Helpful Tip: place the glued bits on the backside of the colored piece of the body)

**Step 3:** Decorate your Dinosaur to your hearts content. You can put spots on it and color it. Do whatever comes to mind. Use your imagination to bring your dinosaur to life!

**Step 4 (Optional):** Once decorated glue onto a piece of construction paper for easy hanging and storing
