Some Construction Paper (Provided in packet!)

A Pair of Scissors

A Pen or Pencil

Instructions:

Step 1: Use your imagination and think about how you want your monster or fairy to look.

For Example:

- Does your monster or fairy have wings?
- Does your monster have tentacles or antennas?
- Is your fairy wearing a tiara?

Step 2: On your construction paper draw out arms, legs, eyes, and all of the body parts you would like your monster or fairy to have.

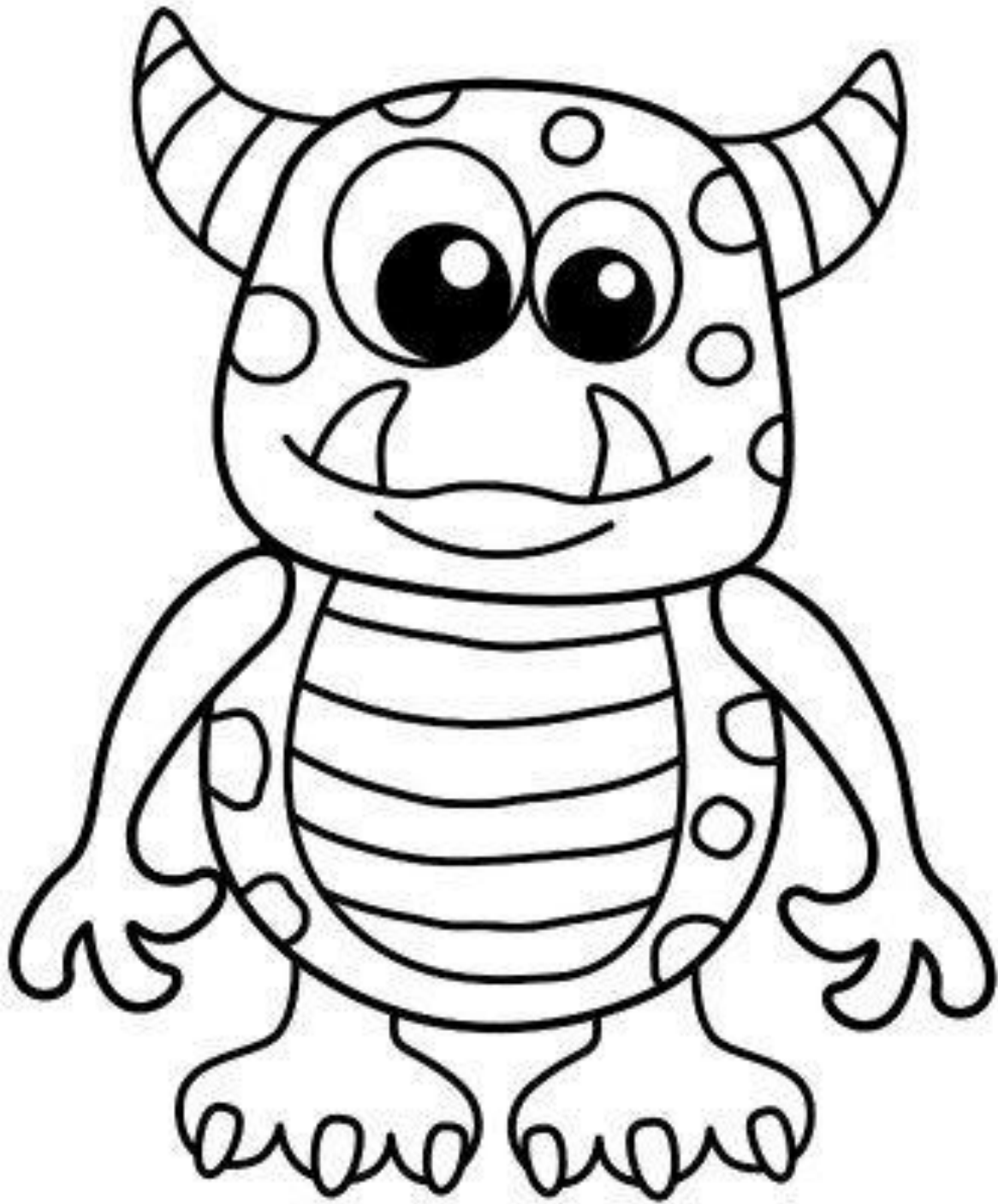
Step 3: Color and decorate the body parts if you wish, and then cut them out.
