Corner Bookmark Origami



Materials:

- A Pair of Scissors
- Glue
- 6x6 Paper (Construction, Printer, Colored Printer, etc.)
- Markers (Color of your choice!)
- Imagination!!

Instructions:

Step 1: After you have made sure that your paper is a square whose sides are 6 inches, fold your paper in half one way and then open it back up. Once done, fold it in half the other way and open it. (Fold it in 4s.)

Step 2: Using your pair of scissors, cut off and remove one of the 4 small squares that you have created with the folds.

Step 3: Turn your paper, holding it diagonally, so that it kind of resembles a heart. With the paper held diagonally, take the two upper squares and fold the outer corners inward, and it will sort of resemble a cat with pointy ears.

Step 4: Now unfold both of the sections you have folded and cut off the little triangle sections you have created.

Step 5: Fold the two triangles that remain inward over top of each other and glue down the top triangle to the bottom triangle.

Step 6: Use your imagination and decorate to your hearts content.
